

THORPE WARD RESIDENTS' ASSOCIATION EXTRACT OF MINUTES FROM MEETING DATED 9TH JANUARY 2017

The following matters were among those discussed at the meeting.

- **1** A faulty street light under the M25 was reported and the Highways Authority will be informed.
- **2** The overgrowth from trees obscuring the lights in Coldharbour Lane has been resolved.
- **3** There is an on-going investigation into finding the name of the contractor who originally repaired the Animal Pound.
- **4** A recent burglary in The Fleetway was discussed and efforts would be made to notify all the residents of The Fleetway and Gower who are not currently members.
- **5** The County Councillor updated the meeting on many of the issues being attended to by SCC.
- **6** The meeting was updated with regard to the Penton Hook Landfill Restoration site.
- **7** The Secretary distributed a report on her activities carried out throughout the month.
- **8** It was reported that a letter had been sent to RBC in regard to their Parking Charge Consultation.
- **9** The on going difficulties regarding double and kerb parking during school drop off and pick up times was discussed. The RBC Parking Enforcement Officer will be advised.
- **10** The Treasurer updated the meeting on his activities during the month and confirmed that the accounts were ready for the Auditor.
- **11** We are still awaiting a response from the Environment Agency with regard to changes to the course of The Bourne.
- **12** The Planning Secretary updated the meeting on the month's planning applications.
- **13** The SCC Planning and Regulatory Committee review of the Milton Park Farm application has been deferred until 22nd March 2017.

- **14** The Local Plan has been delayed to 2018 and ARUP are to relook at the Green Belt.
- **15** An update was provided on the recent workshop held to discuss the River Thames Scheme.
- **16** The TWRA Constitution has been amended and will be put to members for adoption at the AGM.
- **17** The Councillors provided details of their monthly activities.
