The following matters were among those discussed at the meeting.

- 1 Wet Spots around the Ward were discussed with a representative of SCC. The situation continues to be monitored and reported with the possibility of some action by SCC.
- 2 On-going reporting of fly tipping within the Ward. Report on the meeting held with RBC officers.
- 3 Some confusion regarding recent changes to recycling required by new contractors. All residents should have received flyers advising of the new instructions.
- 4 On-going investigation into finding the name of the contractor who originally repaired the Animal Pound.
- 5 Overgrown hedging in Mill Lane to be reported to RBC.
- Report on Remembrance Sunday and work carried out at the Memorial by the TWRA Gardening Group. Thanks were offered to the young man who treated the benches with wood preservative.
- 7 Penton Hook Landfill Restoration Update.
- 8 Secretary's Report including details of the Neighbourhood Watch AGM she attended during the month.
- 9 Treasurer's Report, which included details of the activities of the Community Gardening Group.
- 10 Report on details of a meeting held with the EA in relation to the Bourne changes.
- 11 Town Planning and Allied Matters Planning applications for the past month were discussed.
- Surrey Minerals Plan + Aggregate Recycling: The SCC Planning & Regulatory Committee review of the Milton Park Farm application has been deferred until 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2017.

webiste. The Thorpe Neighbourhood Forum meetings are on-going.

- River Thames Scheme: This is scheduled for completion by 2025 subject to additional funding. The EA are holding a series of meetings details of which have been emailed to members.
